## 7:210 Expulsion Procedures

The final authority for expulsion of a student receiving services from the Cooperative/Joint Agreement lies with the Board of Education of the student's district of residence. District of residence's policy for expulsion of students will be followed, including the due process procedure.

No special education student shall be expelled if the student's particular act of gross disobedience or misconduct is a manifestation of his or her disability. A special education student whose gross disobedience or misconduct is not a manifestation of his/her disability may be expelled pursuant to the expulsion procedures, in accordance with district of residence, provided that the student shall continue to receive educational services as provided in the Individualized Education Program/Plan (IEP) during the period of expulsion.
