Member Districts

Students who are eligible for special education services and are residents of a Member District may participate in the programs available through the Cooperative/Joint Agreement according to provisions in their Individualized Educational Program/Plan (IEP).

Non-Member Districts

Eligible students who are not residents of a Non-Member District may participate in the special education programs available through the Cooperative/Joint Agreement upon the recommendation of the Director and the approval of the Executive Board. For such participation, the non-member district shall pay KASEC the tuition and fees established pursuant to the Article of Joint Agreement and approved by the Executive Board. All enrolled students must comply with the Cooperative's/Joint Agreement's policies on student discipline.
